CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WM. A. AND E. A. MILLER
HOOD RIVER OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF INDIAN CREEK for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and that the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate removes an erroneous point of diversion, correctly describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 14996, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 1979, at Special Order Volume 32, Page 593, approving Transfer Application 4263, and supersedes Certificate 48961, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in the decree.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
