## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILSON CATTLE CO., INC.

P.O. BOX 129

NORTH POWDER, OREGON 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP WELL, in the NORTH POWDER RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 10.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7978. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

6 S	38 E	WM	36	SW NW	1900 feet South and 320 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right is further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a diminishment of a water right approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 06 2008, approving Transfer Application T-7885 and supersedes Certificate 65929, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
