 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SANTOSH BARGE CHANNEL, a tributary of MULTNOMAH SLOUGH (WILLAMETTE RIVER) for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51417. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 12.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

This right is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate facilities for the treatment of the effluent meeting the requirements of the Department of Environmental Quality.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.
