CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CAROL STILL
35 HARVEST LANE
KALISPELL MONTANA 59901

confirms the right to use the waters of CANYON CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1/40th cubic foot per second per acre to June 1 and 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, if available at the original point of diversion, the Dore Mill Ditch, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring water to which the water user is entitled. The types and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Watermaster prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 29, 1979, at Special Order Volume 32, Page 263, approving Transfer Application 4207, and together with Certificate 48349, supersedes Certificate 25221, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
