A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use two wells in the Mill Creek Basin, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under permit G-2882. The date of priority is April 22, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 1.43 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.49 cfs from Well # 3, and 0.94 cfs from Well # 4, if available at the original well; NE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Brown DLC 63, Section 33, T 8 S, R 1 W, WM; 730 feet South and 1180 Feet West from the NW Corner, Lot 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 34, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This right is further limited to a quantity of 308.5 acre-feet per year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THE WELLS ARE LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

Well 3 - LOT 8 (SE ¼ SE ¼), Section 34, Township 8 South, Range 1 West, WM; 669 feet North and 896 feet West from SE Corner, Section 34.

Well 4 - SW ¼ NE ¼, Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 1 West, WM; 2129 feet South and 3580 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 35.

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

WITHIN THE SERVICE AREA OF THE CITY OF SUBLIMITY

Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).


