CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS & JANICE KOHR 62817 FRUITDALE LANE LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the UNNAMED DRAINAGE DITCH, SPRING and RESERVOIR constructed under Permit No. R-6242, tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 77.7 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 38827. The date of priority is January 25, 1974.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic foot per second (CFS), being 0.005 CFS from unnamed drainage ditch and reservoir and 0.005 CFS from spring for stock use, and 0.56 CFS from unnamed drainage ditch and reservoir and 0.11 CFS from spring for irrigation, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6242 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
