CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.08 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28837. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) [if available at the original point of diversion located in the SW SE, as projected within DLC 45, Section 14, T26S, R6W, W.M.; 2550 feet south and 2620 feet west from the E1/4 corner of Section 14], or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring water to which the water user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The use herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate documents the re-description approved by Special Order Volume 77 Pages ~~139-147~~ and supersedes Certificate 81736.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
