CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT AND DOLORES SMITH
1707 DEL RIO RD.
ROSEBURG, OR 97471

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 6.62 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28837. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.076 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the north Umpqua River is 525 cfs at its mouth. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
