CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARY AND SONJA LARSON
1986 DEL RIO RD.
ROSEBURG, OR 97471

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.26 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28837. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.017 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), if available at the original point of diversion or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the North Umpqua River is 525 cfs or more at its mouth. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 60003, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 23 2009, approving a re-description of Certificate 60003.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
