CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

James Noland, Ono A. Baxter, and C. W. Thomas

confirms the right to use the waters of DRY CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 136.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 3272. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.7 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
