 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DUGGER CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 3.25 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3 at Page 321. The dates of priority are 1885 for 2.0 acres and 1903 for 1.25 acres. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a rate of 0.04 cfs per acre. During the season beginning May 1st and ending September 1st, no more than 3 acre feet per acre may be applied. When winter irrigation is practiced the quantity in acre feet of water used shall not be charged against the user delivering his water during the above named season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate confirms a reconsideration order of the Water Resources Director entered on 3-4-09, and recorded in Special Order Volume 77, Page 333, approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This certificate supersedes water right Certificate 1689.
