## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. LAWRENCE and ANNE C. MILLER GIVENS 84462 RINGER RD. MILTON FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of DUGGER CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRGIATION 19.28 ACRES and LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3 at Page 321. The dates of priority are 1890 for 7.68 acres, 1894 for 6.98 acres, 1894 for 6.98 acres, 1900 for 1.05 acres and 1908 for 3.57 acres. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a rate of 1/80th of a cfs per acre. During the season beginning May 1st and ending September 1st, no more than 3 acre feet per acre may be applied. When winter irrigation is practiced the quantity in acre feet of water used shall not be charged against the user delivering his water during the above named season

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the pump consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate confirms a reconsideration order of the Water Resources Director entered on <u>3-4-09</u>, and recorded in Special Order Volume 77, Page <u>333</u> approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This certificate supersedes water right Certificate 75425.
