 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the Umatilla River Basin for IRRIGATION of 7.66 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5215. The date of priority is February 16, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of appropriation, Well 8 located in the SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 14, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 1350 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, NW¼ NW¼, SECTION 14, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 12, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 134, approving Transfer Application 6095, and together with Certificate 65485, supersedes Certificate 53661, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
