## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES CANT DAYVILLE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 47.04 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1899.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre irrigated to June 1 and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs per acre thereafter; further limited to 1.0 ACRE FOOT per calendar month to June 1 and 4.0 ACRE FEET per acre during the season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion. Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
