CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 10.16 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1876.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.254 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52560, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 24 2009, approving Transfer Application T-10704.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
