of Halfway and Corson, respectively, State of Oregon , hus made proof to the sutisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the Main Pine Creek waters of Sneke River . u tributury of , for the purpose of the irrigation of 30 acres of land, and domestic use under Enlargement Permit No. 69 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the lews of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, under and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume , on the 7th day of April, 1915 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from: ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 10.48 cubic foot per second, or its ognival ant in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is uppartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

16 scres in the CE of ST2; Section 35, Township Seven (7) South, Range Fortyfive (45) East of Willamette Meridian; and 15 acres in the ST2 of ST2; Section 23, Township Seven (7) South, Range Forty-three (4%) East of Willamette Meridian, in Eaker County, Orelon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
