 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G.H. RUSSELL
 PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of the OCHOCO, VEAZIE and LAWSON CREEKS, tributary to the CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 13.5 ACRES, DOMESTIC, LIVESTOCK USE AND DEVELOPMENT OF 25 HORSE POWER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1873.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use and power, and 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
