confirms the right to use the waters of McKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION,.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 15 at page 454. The date of priority is JANUARY, 1904.

The right is limited to not more than 0.3145 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows: ELDER DITCH: 90 FEET SOUTH AND 760 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 34 being within the NE¼ SW¼, SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.;

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

APPEAL RIGHTS

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
