CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. DARRELL HOLLIDAY
27542 INDIAN CREEK RD
JOHN DAY OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 96.6 ACRES AND DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1864 FOR 48.3 ACRES AND 1879 FOR 48.3 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and 4.0 acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled. The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 2, 1984, at Special Order Volume 38, Page 127, approving Transfer Application 5420, and together with Certificate 52555, supercedes Certificate 25648, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
