CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VERNON COATES
6221 COATES DRIVE
SALEM, OREGON 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, tributary to the SANTIAM RIVER for IRRIGATION of 51.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 354. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1909.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.64 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

Note: To compensate for losses between the point of diversion to the place of use, an additional amount not exceeding ten percent is allowed.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68668, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 18 2009, approving Transfer Application T-10670.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
