CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILBUR AND DARLINE VANDERBECK 37717 SOUTH HIGHWAY 213 MOUNT ANGEL OREGON 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTE CREEK, tributary to the PUDDING RIVER for IRRIGATION of 23.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 13184. The date of priority is AUGUST 2, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.59 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed one acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30 day period and be limited still further to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the PLACE OF USE and the DUTY and the portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 17290, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by orders of the Water Resources Director, entered July 13, 1982, at Special Order Volume 36, Page 368, approving Transfer Application 5069, and entered July 17, 1984, at Special Order Volume 38, Page 461, approving Transfer Application 5504, and supersedes Certificate 55852, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertain to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
