CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EARL AND DORIS BOYD  
CAVE JUNCTION OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of WILBUR WASTE WATER in SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 31, T 39 S, R 8 W, WM, a tributary of the WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.25 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 15382. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1942. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15604, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 15, 1979, at Special Order Volume 32, Page 438, approving Transfer Application 4253, and an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 31, 1988, at Special Order Volume 42, Page 210, cancelling a portion of the water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
