## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JON H BOWERMAN 42932 CLARNO RD FOSSIL OR 97830

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 5.53 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 12736. The date of priority is JULY 16, 1937. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion located in Lot 3 (NW¼ SW¼, Section 25, T 8 S, R 19 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled. The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 4, 1983, at Special Order Volume 37, Page 224, approving Transfer Application 5186, and supercedes Certificate 12191, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
