CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM RAY ROGERS ROUTE 6, BOX 840 LAKEVIEW, OREGON 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED DRAIN AND ROGERS' RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6705, a tributary of COTTONWOOD CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 3.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42347. The date of priority is AUGUST 4, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75750, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application T-10790. This certificate supersedes Certificate 75750.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
