CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK SPRAGUE RIVER, tributary to SPRAGUE RIVER for LIVESTOCK AND IRRIGATION of 160 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 10, at Page 236. The date of priority is 1886 and 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 4.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, prior to June 15th, and ONE-EIGHTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from March 1st to October 1st of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
