CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALFRED W FABER

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the FERRY CREEK BASIN for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS on 41.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11254. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 140.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE (0.312 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre. For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.. For the irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limed to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same lands.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


This right is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
