This right was perfected under Permit G-8229. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the certificate recorded at page 85501, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 85501 was issued with an incorrect name and incorrectly described the actual number of acres authorized to receive water. This certificate supersedes Certificate 85501.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
