CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of THE DIRECT, PERENNIAL FLOW OF TUMALO CREEK, OR ITS TRIBUTARIES, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for DOMESTIC AND MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

This right was confirmed by order of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County dated August 11, 1926. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Miscellaneous Decree Record of the Water Resources Department in VOLUME 1, PAGE 153.

This right is senior to all other rights on Tumalo Creek.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 6.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Within the City of Bend Service Area

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
