CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 2, 4, AND 5, tributaries of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 128.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3702. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.60 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.60 CFS FROM WELL 2, 0.78 CFS FROM WELL 4, AND 0.22 CFS FROM WELL 5, if available at the original points of appropriation being Well 1 in the NW¼ NE¼; 2340 feet North and 160 feet East, Well 2 in the NW¼ NE¼; 2400 feet North and 330 feet East, and Well 4 in the SW¼ NE¼; 70 feet North and 1310 feet East from the C¼ corner, Section 36, T 4 N, R 27 E, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water appropriated at the new well, together with the quantity of water appropriated from the original wells, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original wells.

The new well (Well 5) shall produce water only from the alluvial materials overlying the Basalts.

The pump system shall include an access port for measuring water level.

The pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 1988, at Special Order Volume 42, Page 293, approving Transfer Application 6078, and supersedes Certificate 50639, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
