confirms the right to use the waters of 2 WELLS, in the BUTTE CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 230.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8561. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.90 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of appropriation: Well 1, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water appropriated at the additional point of appropriation, together with that appropriated at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must abe approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 27, 1990, at Special Order Volume 44, Page 475, approving Transfer Application 6390, and supersedes Certificate 64615, State record of Water Right Certificates.
