 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A A PORTER  
 GRANTS PASS OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of GRAVE CREEK, a tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 31.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1891.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.52 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 16537, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the State Engineer entered September 22, 1959, at Special Order Volume 10, Page 168, approving Transfer Application S-121.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
