CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANNA MARTHA HORSTMANN  
KERBY OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of springs in Section 28, T38S, R8W, W.M., tributary of HENDERSON CREEK for IRRIGATION of 28.90 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Special Order Volume 13, at Page 70. The priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13879, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 12, 2005, approving Transfer Application T-9491. It is issued to correct a scrivener's error in previously-issued remaining right Certificate 81651, the error being the wrong Township number in the location of the springs. This certificate supersedes Certificate 81651.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
