CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM AND SEVENMILE CREEK, tributaries of the COQUILLE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION of 42.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 39867. The date of priority is JULY 14, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM FOR DOMESTIC USE, AND 0.52 CFS FROM SEVENMILE CREEK FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.
