CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BRADLELY E AND KAREN HOUGHTEN
 6700 MILL CREK RD
 THE DALLES OR 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 7.1 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 4.5 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 119. The dates of priority are 1870 (for irrigation) for Tract 1, 1901 (supplemental irrigation and stock) for Tract 4, and 1908 (irrigation) for Tract 5.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed one-sixtieth of a cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st, and one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock, if available at the original points of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (pod) are located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted from Mill Creek at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the right. The original points of diversion are located as follows:

When required by the Watermaster, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Watermaster prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 3, 1978, at Special Order Volume 30, Page 219, approving Transfer Application 3670, and together with Certificate 85658, supersedes Certificate 5693, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The right to the use of the water for the above pupose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
