 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PALMER CREEK WATER DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT CO.
 PO BOX 152
 DAYTON OR. 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMETTE RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 7.3 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 12.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 34436. The date of priority is MAY 28, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The 12.4 acres listed as supplemental irrigation is supplemental to Certificate 53421, and shall be exercised only when water is not available from Holdridge Creek under Certificate 53421.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 13, 2005, at Special Order Volume 65, Page 57, approving Transfer Application 7296, and together with Certificate 81330, supercedes Certificate 64749, State record of Water Right Certificates.
