CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A A PORTER GRANTS PASS OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of GRAVE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 159.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1891.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.65 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion located in the NE¼ SW¼, Section 12, T 34 S, R 6 W, WM; Steam Beer Ditch: 1800 Feet North and 200 feet West from the S¼ corner, Section 12, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

When required by the Watermaster, the water user shall install and maintain a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled. The type and plans of the weir or other suitable device must be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to describe a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 22, 1959, at Special Order Volume 10, Page 168, approving Transfer Application S-121, and together with Certificate 85547, supersedes Certificate 16537, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
