CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the SNAKE RIVER, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33944. The date of priority is OCTOBER 25, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.862 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from March 1 to October 31 of each year.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion previously authorized under Certificate 76948, located approximately at:

To the Oregon/Washington state line.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this allocation of conserved water shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

This certificate is issued to correct the source as listed on Certificate 84703. This certificate also supersedes Certificate 84703.

Certificate 84703 confirmed an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 76, Page 435, approving Conserved Water Application CW-55, and superseded Certificate 76948, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
