CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SARAH A. MOORE  
MT. VERNON, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of FIELDS CREEK, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 16.6 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 79.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1865.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated to June 1 and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during the season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion. The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
