CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That George Emery
of Silver Lake, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Buck Creek
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
LAKE County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 222; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877—Tract #1; 1884—Tract #2.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one second foot to
each 40 acres from March 1st to June 15th and one second foot to each 80 acres
from June 15th to October 1st and the total quantity during any 30 day period
shall not exceed one acre foot per acre and shall not exceed three acre feet
during the irrigation season March 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT #1. 10.7 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 11.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 7.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 28 South,
Range 13 East, W. M., being a total of 70.5 acres.

TRACT #2. 1 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 9 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 15.5 acres in the
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 28 South, Range 13 East, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
