confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 34.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1854.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.97 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.97 CFS from the original point of diversion and 0.804 CFS from the new point of diversion, in any combination, (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: DAVIDSON DITCH: LOCATED IN THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 11, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; DAVIDSON DITCH - NORTH 39 DEGREES 02 MINUTES EAST, 1184 FEET FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER SECTION 11, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

ADDITIONAL POD: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.;
230 feet North and 480 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 3.

DAVIDSON DITCH: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.;
NORTH 39 DEGREES 02 MINUTES EAST, 1184 FEET FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER SECTION 11.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available the original point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen and by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 8, 2004, approving Transfer Application 8966, and together with Certificate 80955, supersedes Certificate 56492, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
