CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. J. BAYLEY JOHN DAY OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE FORK MALHEUR RIVER, a tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 87.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Harney County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 228. The dates of priority are 1887 for Tract 2 and 1888 for Tract 3.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shalhot exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and 1.0 acre foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st of each year, or 3.0 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed ONE-TWENTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
