 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILBUR WASTE WATER in the SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 31, T 39 S, R 8 W, WM, tributary to WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 15382. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1942. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.111 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
