 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. H. TAYLOR
 RUCH OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES, and DOMESTIC and LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1857.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81415, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 29 2009 approving Transfer Applications T-8948 and T-8949.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
