CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING LOCATED IN THE SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 22, T 1 N, R 12 E, WM, tributary to MILL CREEK for DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 119. The date of priority is 1877.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic purposes, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 5693, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 3, 1978, at Special Order Volume 30, Page 219, approving Transfer Application 3670.

The issue of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
