CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

KENT AND CLARENCE WALISER

confirms the right to use LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 10.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-26001. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

5 N	35 E	WM	2	NE NE	650 FEET SOUTH AND 450 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate corrects a scrivener's error in the listing of the place of use and confirms orders of the Water Resources Director entered on November 8, 1999 and December 16, 1999, and recorded in Special Order Volume 53, Pages 1403 – 1406, and Volume 53, Pages 1484 – 1485, approving Transfer Application T-7643.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 84012.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
