CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON STATE BOARD OF CONTROL
SALEM, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to PRINGLE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 90.54 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19311. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.13 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 27139, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 07 2009, and recorded in Special Order Volume 78, pages 302 to 303, canceling a portion of the Certificate 27139.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
