 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of a SLOUGH CHANNEL OF THE WILLAMETTE RIVER, tributary to WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 24.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27567. The date of priority is AUGUST 30, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by Permit G-11253, issued by the Water Resources Director, May 20, 1991, and to correctly describe the place of use, and supersedes Certificate 31314, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
