 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D. S. RIGEL, IRVEN RIGEL and NOAH RIGEL
 WILLIAMS, OREGON 97544

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 28.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2729. The date of priority is November 24, 1915.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed 0.355 cubic foot per second (CFS), or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 50378, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 10, 2009, and recorded in Special Order Volume 78, Pages 443 - 444, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 50378.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
