CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS H. DE ARMOND 11463 BROADACRES RD NE HUBBARD OR 97032

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS, within the MILL CREEK Basin for IRRIGATION of 23.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 74.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8387. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 8, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.57 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original wells, Wells 4 and 5, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at Well 8, together with that diverted at Wells 4 and 5 shall not exceed the quantity of water available from Wells 4 and 5.

When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable measuring devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 28, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 117, approving Transfer Application 6438.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
