confirms the right to store the waters of a SPRING, a tributary of ROCK CREEK, in IRBY FISHPOND, appropriated under Permit 31948, for FISH CULTURE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Permit R-4860. The date of priority is DECEMBER 5, 1966. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 4.0 acre-feet.


